- This in-person Infection Prevention and Control Program (IPAC) is designed to fulfill the new CMS regulations regarding Infection Control and the Infection Preventionist including Phase 3, which includes additional components: F-882 Infection Preventionist Qualifications/Role which become effective **Nov. 28, 2019**.
- The program provides an official Certificate of Mastery from the National Association Directors of Nursing Administration Long-Term Care (NADONA) and 15 contact hours for Florida licensed nurses. The IPAC program is designed to cover all the components of a well-rounded Infection Control Program and the role of the Infection Preventionist (IP).
- This IPAC program is a prerequisite to be eligible to sit for the nationally-recognized NADONA Infection Preventionist Board Certification (IP-BC).
